# Entrance Tests for Top Law Colleges

The Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) is a vital national-level entrance exam in India, serving as the gateway to prestigious National Law Universities (NLUs) and other esteemed law schools. It evaluates candidates on various parameters, including English language, Legal Reasoning, Logical Reasoning, GK & Current Affairs and Quantitative Aptitude. Success in CLAT opens avenues for comprehensive legal education, enabling students to explore diverse career opportunities within the legal field. The exam not only assesses academic aptitude but also identifies individuals with critical thinking and analytical skills, contributing to the shaping of the future legal professionals. CLAT stands as a decisive step for those aspiring to pursue a rewarding and impactful career in law.

## Odds in your favour

With 26 NLUs participating in CLAT, a candidate has more than 3500+ seats up for grabs in these prestigious National Law Universities. The better their rank in CLAT, the higher their chances of getting into a top-ranked NLU of their choice. Efforts that a candidate puts into preparing for CLAT is also useful for appearing in other exams like AILET, SLAT, LNAT, etc, which have similar and overlapping syllabus with slight variations in patterns.

## Eligibility criteria for CLAT

There is no upper age limit for candidates appearing for UG Programme for the CLAT.

- Candidates who have passed in 10+2 or an equivalent examination with a minimum of:
  - Forty five percent (45%) of marks or its equivalent in grade or
  - Forty Percent (40%) of marks or equivalent in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwD categories.
- Candidates appearing for the qualifying examination in March/April, of the following year are also eligible to apply. However, they shall be required to produce evidence of their passing the qualifying examination at the time of admission, failing which they shall lose their right to be considered for admission.

## What skills will be tested?

School level skills in the following areas will be tested for CLAT, with specific weightage for each section.

## CLAT UG Question Format

- Maximum Marks : 120
- Duration of CLAT Exam : 02:00 Hours
- Multiple-Choice Questions : 120 questions of one mark each
- Negative Marking : 0.25 Mark for each wrong answer

Subject Areas with weightage	(approximate number of questions)
English Language	22-26 questions, or roughly 20% of the paper
Current Affairs, including General Knowledge	28-32 questions, or roughly 25% of the paper
Legal Reasoning	28-32 questions, or roughly 25% of the paper

Quantitative Techniques	10-14 questions, or roughly 10% of the paper

NLU Delhi is one of the topmost law schools in the country with the added advantage of its location in the capital which gives access to the Supreme Court, Delhi High Court, Parliament, top law firms and much more to candidates spending 5 years in the NLU Delhi campus.

## Eligibility:

Candidates have passed the Higher Secondary School Examination (10+2) system or an equivalent examination thereto securing in the aggregate not less than 45% of the total marks (42% in case of OBC's and 40% for SC/ST/Person with Disability). The Eligibility condition for admission of students under the Foreign Nationals Category shall be 65% marks in the Higher Secondary School Examination of (10+2) system or an equivalent examination.

## AILET Test Structure:

The AILET for UG programme will have three (3) sections of 150 multiple choice questions for 150 marks in total. The duration of the examination is 120 minutes.

Name of Section	No. of Questions	Marks
English Language	50	50
Current Affairs & General Knowledge	30	30
Logical Reasoning	70	70

Legal principles may be used in the logical reasoning section to test logical aptitude but the examination will not require any kind of legal knowledge or technical understanding.

**Negative marking:** There will be Negative Marking in AILET. The criteria for negative marking will be based on the formula  $0.25 \times 4 = 1$  that means per wrong answer 0.25 Marks will be deducted. Therefore, four wrong answers will lead to deduction of 1 Mark.

If two or more candidates get the same marks at the All India Law Entrance Test (AILET), their merit will be determined on the basis of higher marks in the section on LOGICAL REASONING in the AILET.

If the merit is still the same, then the candidate senior in age shall get preference. If still there is no change in merit, then computerized draw of lots shall be taken into consideration.

LNAT was developed by a consortium of UK universities as a fair way to assess a candidate's potential to study law at undergraduate level, regardless of their education or personal background.

The LNAT is designed to be a test of aptitude rather than educational achievement. The skills that candidates need to do well in the LNAT are also the skills that they need to do well in legal education.

**LNAT Test format :**

The LNAT is a 2¼ hour test in two sections

**Section A:**

This section consists of 42 multiple choice questions. The questions are based on 12 argumentative passages, with 3 or 4 multiple choice questions on each. You will be given 95 minutes to answer all of the questions.

**Section B:**

In section B, you will have 40 minutes to answer one of three essay questions on a range of subjects to demonstrate your ability to argue economically and to come to a conclusion. You will need a good command of written English.

Symbiosis is one of the most prestigious private law colleges in India with campuses in Pune, Noida, Hyderabad and Nagpur. To get into one of these campuses one has to clear SLAT followed by a written ability test and a personal interview. It is a paper of 60 marks with 60 MCQs to be completed in 60 minutes.

**Eligibility:**

Passed Standard XII (10+2) or equivalent examination from any recognized Board with a minimum of 45% marks or equivalent grade (40% marks or equivalent grade for Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes)

**Test Structure for LL.B. 5 Yrs**

## Frequently Asked Questions

### When is the CLAT exam held?

CLAT is held annually, usually in the first week of December. However, the specific date may vary each year, and candidates are advised to check the official website for the most up-to-date information regarding the examination schedule.

### Are the board marks or subject stream important for CLAT aspirants?

No, a candidate is eligible to appear for CLAT irrespective of his stream in class 11th and 12th. Board exam marks do not play any role in terms of weightage. However, a minimum of 45% is required for the student to be eligible to write the paper.

### What is the exam pattern for CLAT?

The CLAT exam pattern includes 120 multiple-choice questions spread across five sections: English Language, Current Affairs, Legal Reasoning, Logical Reasoning, and Quantitative Techniques. The test is offline, has a 2-hour duration, and a total of 120 marks. For scoring, each correct answer gets 1 mark, while each incorrect answer results in a deduction of 0.25 marks.

### How many NLUs participate in CLAT?



### What opportunities does CLAT open for candidates?



### Is my CLAT score accepted by non-NLUs for admission?


